<b>4. Eligibility of graduates for employment and further training</b>

In the second and third year, students write and defend term papers focused on their assimilation of theoretical knowledge and solving specialized managerial tasks in the field of national security. During the last year of study, students write a qualifying (bachelor's) thesis, which is also presented and discussed with the participation of teachers, fellow students and reviewed by an external reviewer.
