

Heads of the Department:

The first Head of the Department in 2000 was PhD in Philosophy science Victor Tsyganov. During 2001-2016 The Headed of the Department was Doctor of Science in Public Administration, Professor, Honored Worker of Science and Technology of Ukraine Sytnyk Hryhoriy. From the end of 2016 until the reorganization of NAPA under the President of Ukraine, the Department of Global Studies, European Integration and National Security Management was headed by PhD in Law Yuriy Melnyk. At present, the head of Global and National Security Department is Hryhoriy Sytnyk.

Personalities who worked at the Department:

At various times, the lectures of the Department were well-known statesmen, scientists in the field of national security and management specialists, such as:

Yevhen Marchuk, PhD in Law, General of the Army of Ukraine, who in different years held the positions of Prime Minister, Secretary of the National Security and Defense Council of Ukraine, Minister of Defense of Ukraine, Head of the Security Service of Ukraine;

Volodymyr Gorbulin, Academician of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine, Doctor of Technical Sciences, Professor, currently the First Vice President of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine, who in various years held the positions of Secretary of the National Security and Defense Council of Ukraine;

Zinovii Kulik, PhD in Historic Science, prominent Ukrainian TV journalist, who started one of the first all-Ukrainian Ukrainian-language weekly publications - socio-political magazine "Politics and Culture" (PiK) and held, in particular: Minister of Information, Deputy Secretary of the National Security and Defense Council of Ukraine Chairman of the State Committee for Television and Radio Broadcasting.

Volodymyr Shkidchenko, PhD in Military Science, General of the Army of Ukraine, who in different years held the positions of Minister of Defense of Ukraine, Chief of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, Deputy Head of the of Ukraine's NATO Mission for Military Affairs;

Vasyl Krutov, Doctor of Law, Professor, Lieutenant General of the Security Service of Ukraine, who in various years held the positions of First Deputy Secretary of the National Security and Defense Council of Ukraine, First Deputy Head of the Security Service of Ukraine, Head of the Anti-Terrorist Center of the Security Service of Ukraine, the first Head of the Ukrainian "Alpha";

Ihor Romanchenko, Doctor of Military Sciences, Professor, Head of the Central Research Institute of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, Lieutenant General;

Andrii Semenchenko, Doctor of Science in Public Administration, Professor, who at various times held senior positions related to national security, in particular, was First Deputy Chairman of the State Committee for Informatization of Ukraine, Chairman of the National Commission for State Regulation of Communications and Informatization, Director of the Department of Military Policy and Strategic Planning of the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine;

Oleksandr Sukhodolia, Doctor of Science in Public Administration, Professor, Deputy Chairman of the State Committee for Energy Conservation of Ukraine, Deputy Head of the National Security and Defense Council of Ukraine, and currently Head of the Energy and Technogenic Security Department of the National Institute for Strategic Studies.

Interesting Facts:

During 2010-2017 (until the abolition of training in the specialty "Public Administration in the field of national security" - in connection with the approval in 2015 by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine of a new list of fields of knowledge and specialties for training higher education), teaching staff of the Department of National Security with the participation of other departments and leading specialists of Ukraine in the field of national security was trained almost 500 masters of public administration in the field of national security. Many of them today hold senior positions in the system of public administration. Among them, in particular: Mykola Chechotkin - Head of the State Service of Ukraine for Emergencies, Colonel-General of the Civil Protection Service; Oleksandr Polishchuk - Deputy Minister of Defense of Ukraine, Major General of the Reserve; Ihor Romanchenko, Doctor of Military Sciences, Professor,

Head of the Central Research Institute of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, Lieutenant General.

Through the efforts of the teaching staff of the department, a number of research works (R&D) were performed and monographic studies and textbooks were prepared and published, which played a significant role in the development of theory and practice of public administration in the field of national security. Among them, in particular, monographs: "Conceptual framework for the functioning of public administration of national security" and "Theoretical and methodological principles of passports of threats to national security of Ukraine" (2012), as well as textbooks: "Public administration in national security (conceptual and organizational - legal principles)" (2012) and "Global and National Security" (2016).

In addition, for the first time in Ukraine, a Comprehensive Methodology for Assessing Threats to the State in the Domestic Policy Sphere was developed within the Scientific research work, which was commissioned by the National Security and Defense Council of Ukraine in 2013.

It should be noted that the teaching staff of the department takes an active part in improving their skills. Prof. Hryhorii Sytnyk, Prof. Rena Marutian and Associate Prof. Larysa Shypilova have been studied and passed an internship at the S. George Marshall European Center for Security Studies in Garmisch-Partenkirchen, Germany. An important role in solving this problem belongs to the annual scientific-practical seminar "Challenges and threats to Ukraine's security in the XXI century: problems and ways to solve them".
